Behaviors Critical to Social-Emotional Competence

1 Child participates in healthy interactions

2 Child expresses a range of emotions

3 Child regulates social-emotional responses

4 Child begins to show empathy for others responses

5 Child attends to and engages with others responses

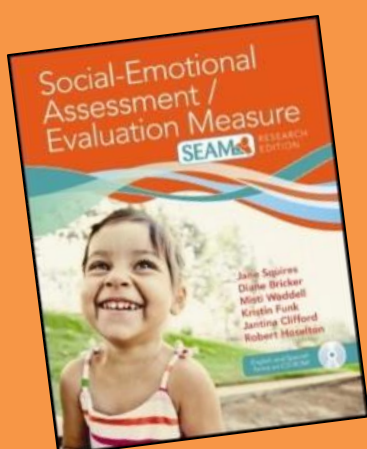
6 Child explores hands and feet and surroundings (for infants) / demonstrates independence (for toddlers/preschoolers)

7 Child displays a positive self-image

8 Child regulates activity level

9 Child cooperates with daily routines and requests
