Dr. Diane Bricker teams up with fellow researchers from the University of Oregon. Their mission: Design a **valid, cost-effective, and culturally sensitive** screening tool for young children at risk for developmental delays.

Dr. Bricker partners with Dr. Jane Squires for intensive research. They identify a key set of skills parents can easily observe at home—and spend years crafting, testing, & refining the ASQ questionnaires.



1997



The Individual with Disabilities Act (IDEA) of 1997 passes, increasing the demand for screening.

1997–1998

ASQ:SE items are reviewed by experts in mental health, education, early childhood development, pediatrics, and nursing. Validity, reliability, and utility studies are conducted.

GOING GLOBAL

International ASQ research begins. Early studies are conducted in Finland and Norway.

Over **4 years** ASQ researchers collect **18,000 questionnaires** on children from all **50 states**.

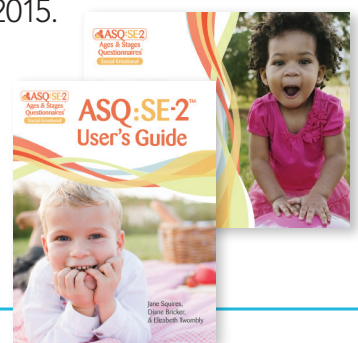
The ASQ team starts collecting data for a third edition, ASQ-3.

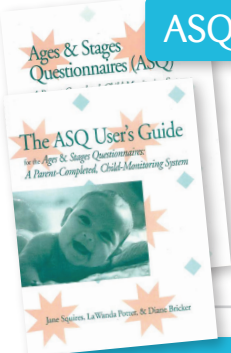

The ASQ team starts developing an in-demand companion tool—Ages & Stages Questionnaires®: Social-Emotional (ASQ:SE).

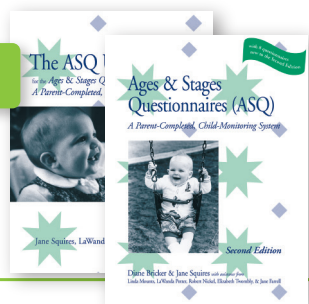


Eight new ASQ questionnaires are developed for 10, 14, etc. months. Now kids can be screened more frequently—and get the services they need sooner.

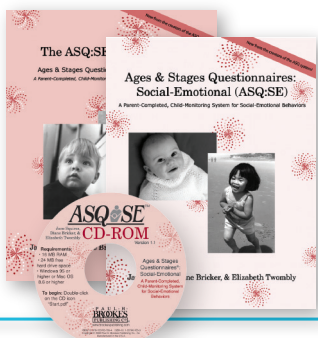
