## LOCATION

## What is the Elite Palace hotel's address?

## When do I need to check-out of the hotel?

Check-out is 12:00 noon. Luggage storage is available at the hotel for a nominal fee.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

**How far away is the airport?** *The Elite Palace Hotel, Stockholm, is located 25m (40 km) from the Arlanda International Airport.* 

## **Transportation Options:**

The Flightbus (Flygbussarna) goes directly from the airport to the hotel by way of Norra Stationsgatan, and the hotel is located approximately 55 yd (50 m) from this station.

#### Taxi:

There are different taxi companies and they have different rates. But there are three companies that the Elite Palace Hotel, Stockholm recommends:

TAXI STOCKHOLM (black cab with yellow sign) - 520 SEK TAXI KURIR – (black or dark blue car with blue double arrow sign) 497 SEK TAXI 020 (yellow cab) 470 SEK

## Do I need to pay to park at the hotel?

Elite Palace Hotel, Stockholm, has a parking garage with limited spaces. The fee is 295 SEK/night based on availability upon arrival. If there are no spaces left, then there is a garage just behind the hotel that is

government owned, and costs approximately the same. It is free of charge to park on the streets from 5:00 PM to 9:00 AM, but parking has to be in legal spots.

#### What are the hours of the Symposium?

The Symposium hours are: Monday, June 6 - 4:15 PM-7:30 PM (16:15-19:30) Tuesday, June 7 - 8:30 AM-5:15 PM (08:30-17:15)
