

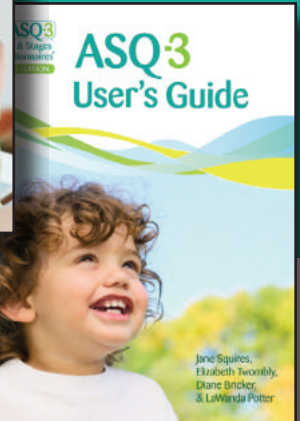
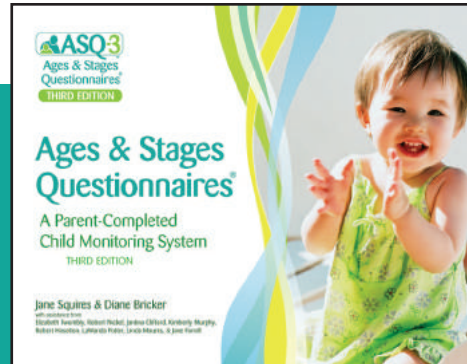

# ASQ-3 AT A GLANCE



<b>Type of screening</b>	Developmental screening
<b>Areas screened</b>	Communication, Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Problem Solving, and Personal Social
<b>Age range</b>	1–66 months
<b>Number of questionnaires</b>	21
<b>Age intervals (in months)</b>	2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 30, 33, 36, 42, 48, 54, and 60
<b>Number of items</b>	30 per questionnaire (6 for each area screened)
<b>Sample item</b>	Does your child stack a small block or toy on top of another one? (18-month questionnaire, Fine Motor area)
<b>Reading level of items</b>	4th to 6th grade
<b>Who completes it</b>	Parents (professionals may also if they know the child well)
<b>Time to complete</b>	10–15 minutes
<b>Who scores it</b>	Professionals (teachers, child care providers, nurses, home visitors, early interventionists, clerical staff, pediatricians, and more)
<b>Time to score</b>	2–3 minutes
<b>Scores provided</b>	5 raw scores, one for each area
<b>What the scores tell you</b>	The raw scores are compared to cutoff points for each area, which show whether the child may need further assessment, should be monitored and rescreened, or is doing well.
<b>Photocopiable</b>	Yes
<b>Languages</b>	Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Spanish, and Vietnamese
<b>Training</b>	Not required but encouraged! Training DVDs available for purchase as well as in-person introductory and train-the-trainer seminars through Brookes On Location.
<b>Standardization sample</b>	18,527 questionnaires for 15,138 children from diverse racial and socio-economic backgrounds
<b>Reliability</b>	Test-retest: .92 (excellent) Inter-rater: .93 (excellent)
<b>Validity</b>	.82 to .88 (excellent)
<b>Sensitivity</b>	.86 (excellent)
<b>Specificity</b>	.85 (excellent)
<b>Years in development</b>	30 years
