# Preparing for the 2019-2020 Kansas Kindergarten Readiness Snapshot

Dear Administrator,

All Kansas kindergarten classrooms are required to administer the Ages & Stages Questionnaires (ASQ-3 and ASQ:SE-2) between August 1 and September 20, 2019. See below for guidance and a review of features to help you prepare for the initiative.

#### Archive Data from the 2018-2019 School Year

You will want to be sure to archive your students from the 2018-2019 school year before you begin this year's screening initiative. When you archive child records in ASQ Online, the records no longer appear on the active child page and you are not able to enter screening data. The data still remains in your account and you are able to generate reports as needed. Watch this <a href="mailto:short video">short video</a> for instructions on how to archive your student data.

## **Review your Family Access Pages**

Make sure your ASQ-3 and ASQ:SE-2 Family Access Pages are linked. Linking your ASQ-3 and ASQ:SE-2 pages will allow your caregivers to complete both questionnaires at the same time without having to reenter child and caregiver demographic information. ### **Creating New Administrators/Teachers**

KSDE contacted each superintendent in May to confirm listed Administrators (users who can assign Provider login credentials to teachers) are still accurate. **As Administrator, you have the ability to create new users for your program.** Adding multiple teachers can easily be done with the new import provider feature. Simply enter the necessary information into the import template (last name, first name, username, email address, phone number), upload the import file to ASQ Online, and user accounts will automatically be created for your users.
