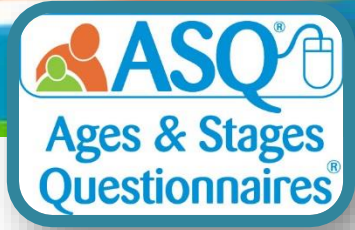
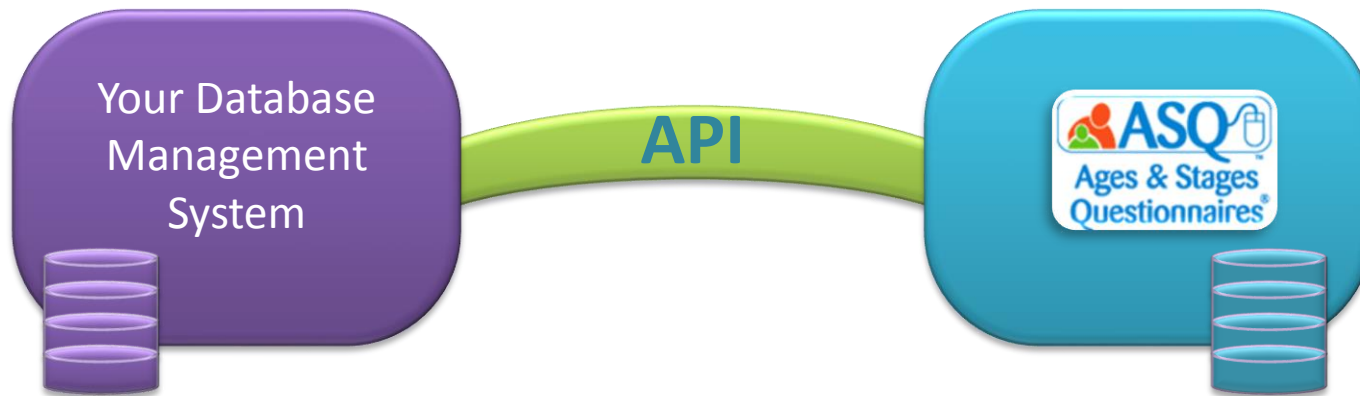
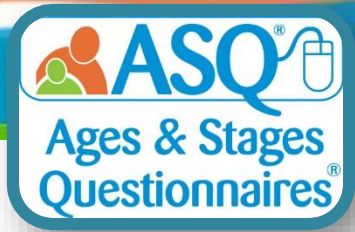


# WHAT IS ASQ® Online API?

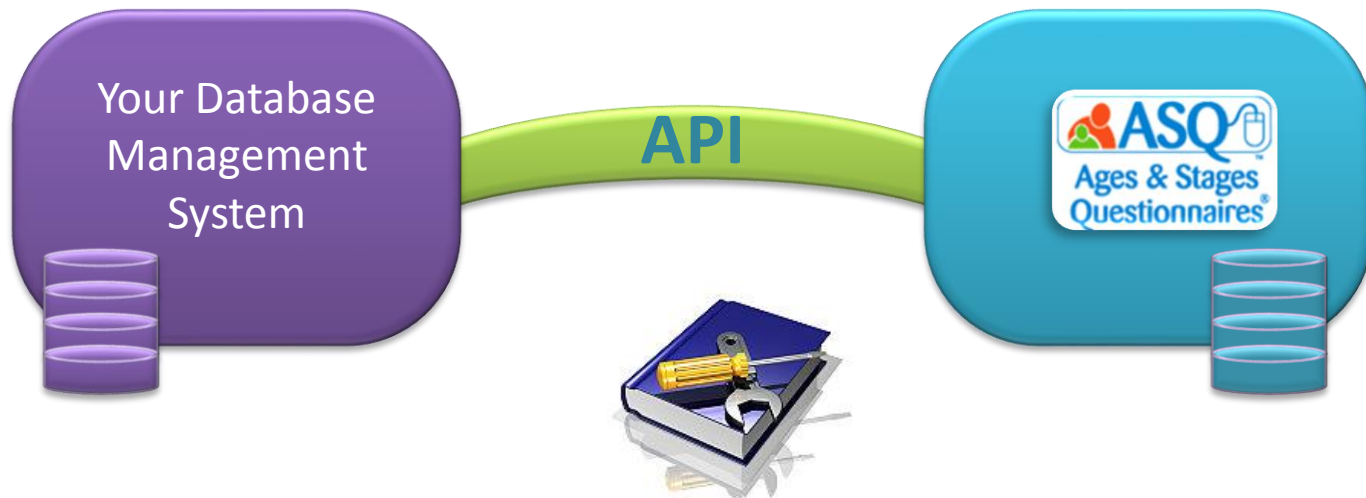
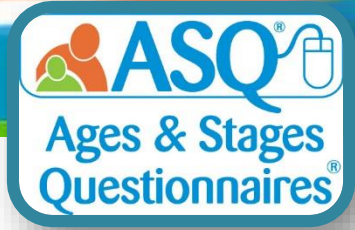




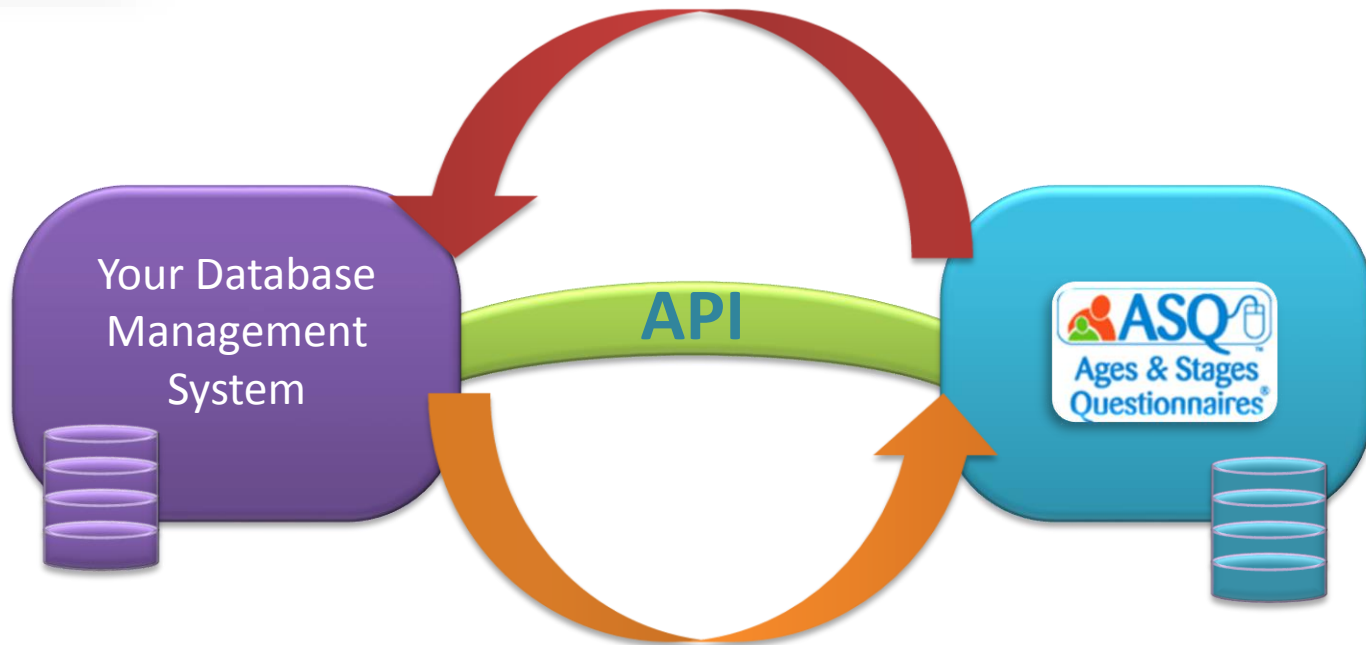
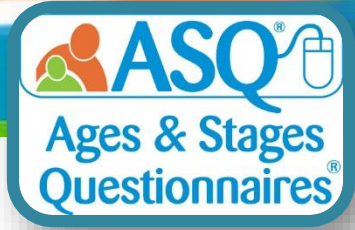
- ❖ API (Application Programming Interface)

- ❖ Automated way to import and export data between an ASQ Online account and an external customer database management system



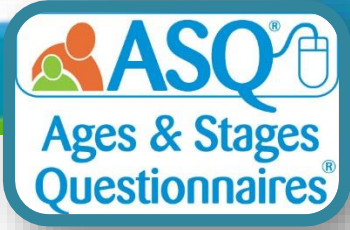
API is the bridge that allows two database systems to connect.



ASQ Online provides the tools and instructions to allow your developer or IT professional to create the bridge.

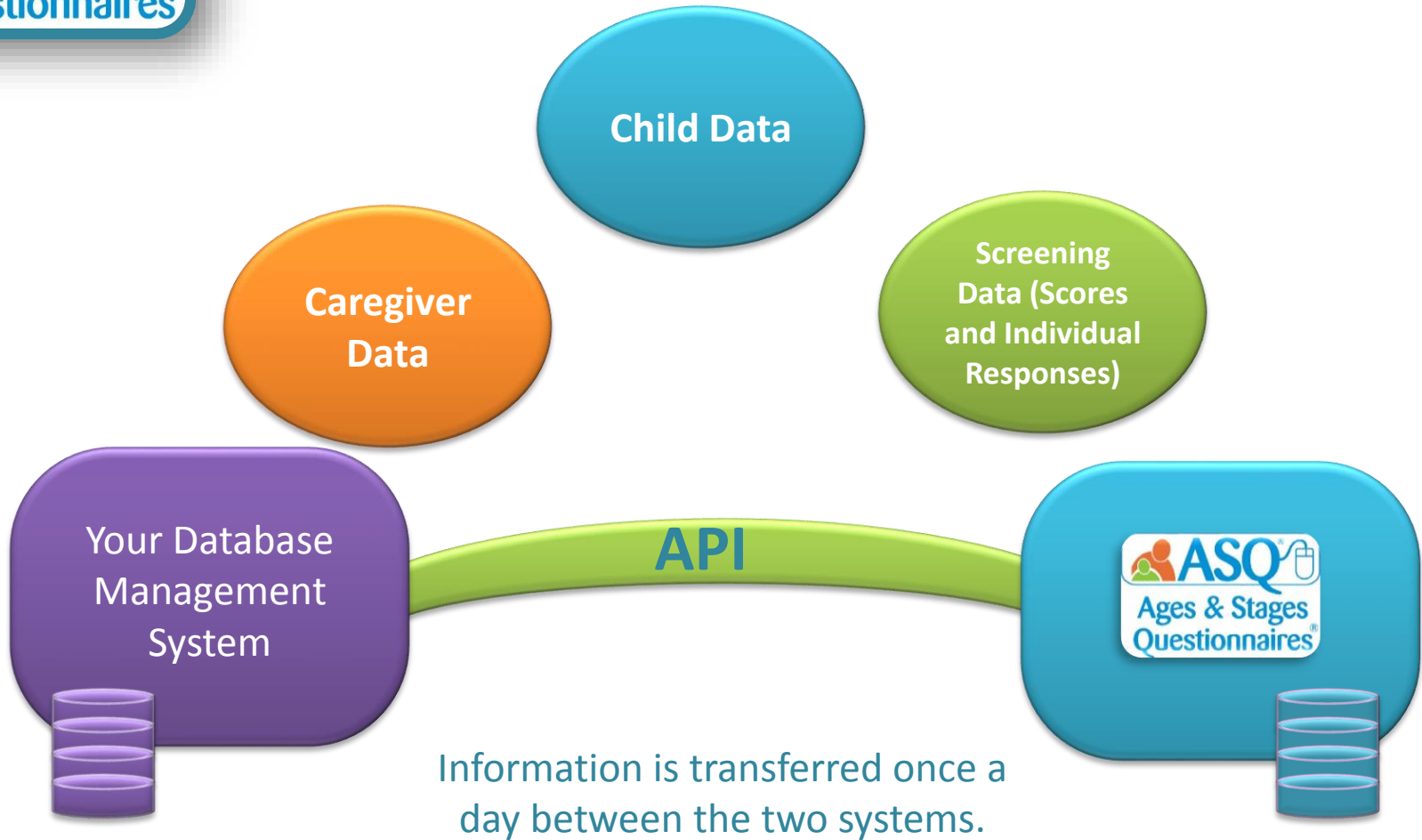
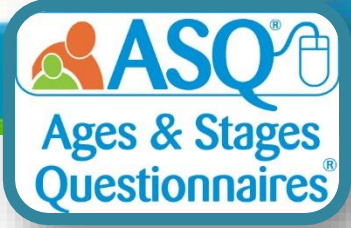


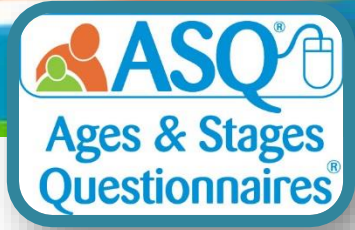
Once the bridge has been created, data

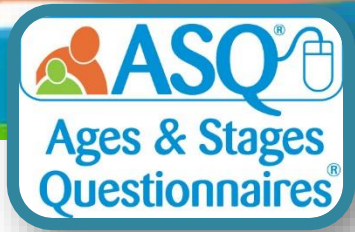






# How do I get started with API?





Step 1

Purchase the API add-on subscription.

Step 2

Generate the API tokens for your account or programs within your account (Instructions to generate tokens will be available in the *API Quick Start Guide for Admins*). Your developer or IT professional will need the API tokens to open up access to your account or program data and create the bridge.

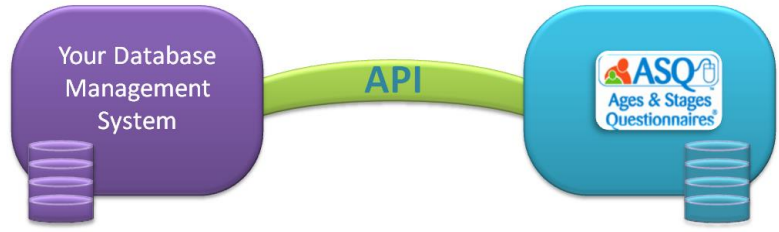
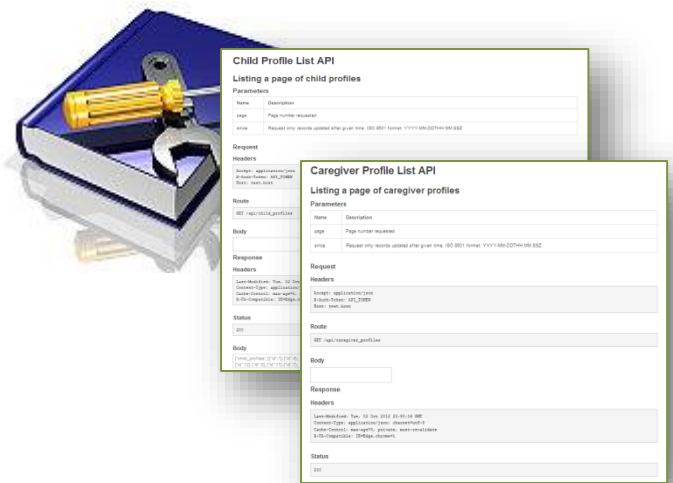


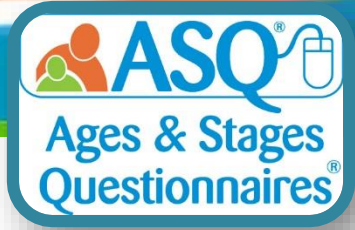
Step 3
