



How to use the ASQ Age Administration Charts:

This resource helps providers to determine the best time frame for administering the ASQ-3 and ASQ:SE-2. Each Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) has a specific age administration window. For example, the 12-month ASQ-3 “window” is from 11 months 0 days to 12 months 30 days. The ASQ age calculation tools[‡] can be used to determine a child’s age in months and days and which ASQ should be administered.

While EFS Mod will choose the correct questionnaire for a child on the day you log in, these Age Administration Charts make sure the child will not “age out” of the questionnaire before it is likely to be completed. If the child’s age is less than a week away from the end of an ASQ window, it may be best to wait a few days and begin to complete the next ASQ questionnaire.

ASQ-3 Guidelines:

When completing an ASQ-3, parents/providers should:

- 1) Make sure the child is rested, fed, and ready to play
- 2) Try each activity before marking a response (unless child is already demonstrating the skill)
- 3) Make completing the ASQ-3 a fun, engaging activity. If a child is unwilling to try activities, skip to another section of the ASQ-3 or try again another day.

Timing is more important with the ASQ-3 (than the ASQ:SE-2). Following the ASQ-3 guidelines means that it may take several days to complete an ASQ-3. Whenever possible, it is recommended to make paper copies of the ASQ-3 available to parents/providers or teachers BEFORE they enter information into EFS Mod. This makes it easier to watch for skills over a period of time before answering.

ASQ:SE-2 Guidelines:

The ASQ:SE-2 can be completed online at any time by a parent or caregiver who knows the child well. When completing an ASQ:SE-2 questionnaire, parents/providers should:

- 1) Answer questions based on what you know about your baby’s behavior.
- 2) Answer questions based on your baby’s usual behavior, not behavior when your baby is sick, very tired, or hungry.
- 3) Caregivers who know the baby well and spend more 15–20 hours per week with the baby may complete ASQ:SE-2.
