Make the Most of Your ASQ Learning Activities

If your school is already using ASQ Learning Activities, take a moment to ensure they're linked in ASQ Online. Use the step-by-step instructions below to check that your keycodes have been added successfully.

1. Login to ASQ Online as your Program Administrator role.
2. Select **Program** from the main menu.
3. Scroll down to the *Keycodes* tab and click *View All*. Look for “Learning Activities” under the Product name.
4. If your ASQ-3 or ASQ:SE-2 Learning Activities keycodes are not yet entered, you can find each keycode on a sticker on the inside of the book's front cover. Click *Add*, type in the keycode, and click *Save*.
